



Best Recess Layout Instructions

Little Yellow Bicycle Head of the Class Materials:

- HC-101 – Back to School patterned paper
- HC-106 – Geometry patterned paper
- HC-279 – Chipboard Shapes
- HC-220 – Fabric Favorites
- HC-134 – Journaling Cards
- HC-307 – Mini Banners
- HC-135 – Cardstock Stickers – Favorite Pieces
- HC-140 – Cardstock Stickers – Fresh Verse
- HC-195 – Dimensional Pop-Up Stickers
- SS-197 – Sweet Summertime Jewel Stickers

Tools and Other Materials:

- Die cutter
- Circle cutter
- Foam Tape
- Tape runner
- Scissors
- Black felt tip marker
- White cardstock

1. Cut the Geometry patterned paper into a 6 x 6 die cut shape of your choice (shape on the layout is from Spellbinders Grand Nestabilities – Grand Labels One), ink the edges.
2. Cut a 1.5 inch circle from white cardstock to back the “Cool Kid” chipboard shape. Ink the edges.
3. Add the cardstock sticker ruler from the Favorite Pieces sheet to the Back to School patterned paper about 2.5 inches from the bottom just above the school buses on left.
4. Glue the Geometry paper shape ½ inch from the left side of the edge and just slightly overlapping the ruler on the bottom.
5. Glue the Think, Speak, Love black Journal Card to the right side of the page so that it is at an angle and slightly overlaps the ruler.
6. Back the two 4 x 6 photos with white cardstock to make a subtle photo matte and then glue them to the page so they both overlap the yellow ruler sticker, but the photo on the left is about ¾ inches above the photo on the right.
7. Cut the red chipboard label so that about an inch of it shows and glue to the right of the photo. Add the Dimensional Pop-Up Sticker.
8. Glue the “Cool Kid” chipboard circle shape to the white cardstock circle, ink the edges and then add stitches with a black felt marker to the outer edge. Use pop dots or foam tape to glue to the page.
9. Add the “Best” Mini Banner for the title in the top right corner of the page just under the busses. Add the “recess” cardstock sticker to some white cardstock, ink the edges and use pop dots or foam tape to glue it to the page just below the mini banner.
10. Add the cardstock sticker stars to the page around the title. Use pop dots or foam tape to add loft. Add a Fabric Favorite star to the middle of the yellow cardstock sticker star. Add bling to the centers of the stars, the dimensional pop-up and the “Cool Kid” chipboard.
