Basic Banner Instructions:

Pick your papers out for each banner piece. I love the Paper Pads that match the Chipboard Albums, it takes some of the cutting out and makes it quicker for me.

After I got my papers picked and glued down to my banner pieces, I added the border pieces on the bottom of each panel. I punch my border and then measure the pieces before cutting the lengths. The blue piece measure approximately 2 inches tall and the white border piece is approximately 1.5 inches tall. I used the shorter side of the paper pad pieces so that the width was already measured for me. I then layered the white on top of the blue and then attached them to the bottom of each banner piece. I then added pleated ribbon over the top just to make it pretty. SEE TIP for first banner piece before adhering the pleated ribbon on the first panel.

For the tops of each piece I used some of the 6 x 6 decorative edged cardstock. The first and third panels I cut from the same piece, just opposite ends. From the top of the piece to the center of the very bottom of the piece measures approximately 2.25 inches. The center panel piece from the top to the longer side point is approximately 2.25 inches. You will need to trim a little on each side, because they are wider than the chipboard.

To finish off the banner, I punched holes with a CropADile and strung ribbon thru the hole. In the middle of the ribbon that separates each banner piece, I made an accordion fold medallion and used a Snowflake Button Dot in the middle. I also used jute string behind the medallion just to tie them into the over all banner.

Details for Banner Piece 1

Tree made from Sketch Support sketch, link is provided.

Cut circles out of some of the packaging backing that is flecked with blue. Then cut them in half and layer to make hills.

Place everything but your mini snowflakes. Then you can place your mini snowflakes around your pieces using dimensional adhesive.

TIP...I adhered the pleated ribbon after placing the hills and tree.

Details for Banner Piece 2

Use the square 6 x 6 piece of striped square decorative cardstock, trim a little off the top and bottom. Flip those trimmed pieces over and attach them back to your square, just match up the points and it will give you a little different look.

Attach your Fresh Verse with dimensional adhesive.

Using one of the Medley Album envelopes, I turned it inside out and cut off the bottom. I then border punched the cut off part, folded it over the end and reattached it. This makes the envelope shorter to fit in the area. The part I cut off was approximately 1.5 inches. Tie twine around and then place a snowflake on top of the twine with dimensional adhesive and slip your clear cut bird underneath. I then slipped a couple of chipboard pinecones underneath the side of the pocket. Place your snowman peeking out into your pocket.

Details for Banner Piece 3

Using one of the papers from the Paper Pad, I framed one of the Medley Album inserts and used another insert to slip underneath it just a bit. I used one of the snowflake button dots and looped jute string behind it and attached it to the tag I have slipped underneath. I then used the 5 Things saying and just added some jute string behind it to create the loops and made it the title of this banner piece.

I attached the chipboard “brrrrrrr” saying with dimensional adhesive and then looped the acetate mitten pair underneath it. I also attached the “FUN” snowflake from the cardstock sticker sheet on my list of things I love about snow!
